

CONTINUOUS SYNOPSIS RECORD – CSR

According to SOLAS Chapter XI-1, rule 5, all passenger and cargo vessels of 500 grt and more in international trade are to carry documentation on board concerning the history of the vessel, a :
"Continuous Synopsis Record" - CSR

FORM 1

The Norwegian Ship Registers are responsible for issuing CSR DOCUMENTS (FORM 1) with amendments. The documents are numbered sequentially across change of flags throughout the ship's lifetime.

The CSR Documents are always to be kept on board in original.

APPLICATION for CSR

To be used for issuance of a ship's CSR Document No. 1

FORM 2

Please notify all amendments to items no. 1- 13 in the CSR Document on FORM 2 (amendment form).

This form should be signed by the ISM-liable company or the master.

The original is always to be kept on board – a copy is to be forwarded to the register.

FORM 3

Is to be completed by the ISM-liable company or the captain and is an "Index of Amendments to the CSR".

This is to be kept on board the ship.

CSR-HISTORY

The CSR DOCUMENT (FORM 1), FORM 2 (amendment form) and FORM 3 (index of amendments) all make up the ship's CSR-History and are to be kept on board, in original, throughout the ship's lifetime.

ISM-LIABLE COMPANY

To register the management company responsible for ISM, please use form KR-0014E, "Notification of Assignment of responsibilities imposed by the ISM-Code".

This form must be signed by both the formal/registered owner of the vessel and by its designated management company responsible for ISM.

The original form is to be forwarded to the Ship Registers for registration and return to the ISM-liable company, stamped and signed.

FORM 2 and FORM 3 and KR-0014E are all available on our website, www.nis-nor.no where a search of last issued CSR's is now also available.

Responsibility for the regulations and for following up the above SOLAS provisions lies with the Norwegian Maritime Directorate, www.sjofartsdir.no
The Norwegian Ship Registers (NIS/NOR) has only the registration function and is responsible for issuing the CSR document
